Our Father, Holy Mary, and the Glory With Ecclesiastical Permission (For private use) Maria del Carmen González-Valerio y Sáenz de Heredia, was born in Madrid on 14 March 1930. In a profound catholic family she was the second of five children. Her parents consecrated her to the Virgin Mary before birth, and after they again dedicated her on several pilgrimages to the Virgin's principal sanctuaries.

The Lord was in a hurry to make her His, as she was baptized a few hours after birth. At the age of two years she was confirmed and from then on demonstrated symptoms of an inner soul inexplicable for one of her age, if it were not by the Divine Grace. With irrepressible eagerness to receive the Eucharist, she prepared with enthusiasm, serenity—and an interest very rare for her tender age—for her First Communion, which she took at the age of six on 25th of June 1936.

For her, everything was concentrated in Jesus; she had a great devotion to his Spirit and spent all her savings on propagating it. She felt a great repugnance towards lies and was very grateful for any service done for her.

Everyone felt very happy by her side. The Faith illuminated all her life and since she was very small she had a clear concept of Saintliness (Piety) following the example of Christ.

Her characteristic virtues were: Purity and Charity. Of the first she gave constant proof defending it at all costs. The second she practiced with everyone giving her best things; and above all, giving herself in total surrender and offering her very life to God for the salvation of those who had executed her father by shooting on 29 August 1936. It was on Holy Thursday, 6th of April 1939, after the Communion when the Lord accepted her sacrificial offering; she died on the Cross on 17 July 1939, after suffering without complaint. Obedient to all and repeating the names of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. Having predicted the day of her entrance into Heaven and that the Virgin Mary would come to seek her. She was nine years old and had already filled a great supernatural life. One day in school, after confession with all the young girls, the Father who heard the confession said, "This child is full of the Holy Spirit."

Mary Carmen has bestowed many Graces from Heaven. Her Beatification Cause was begun in Madrid on the 11 July 1961. We implore those who obtain graces to communicate to:
